"3 month internship" starting in September 2016

All Together in Dignity – ATD in Ireland is seeking a motivated intern to join our team and help us in our upcoming campaigns.

The intern will have the opportunity to get first hand work experience in the Human Rights field by being involved with the organisation of a number of events and campaigns, learning from ATD long-term volunteers and working through a grassroots level approach to poverty.

About us:

All Together in Dignity – ATD Fourth World is an international human-rights organisation that works through grass-roots projects in partnership with people living in poverty. All around the world, it remains focused on constantly reaching out to the most vulnerable families, those who have a long history of poverty and educational disadvantage even in the so-called developed countries.

For the past 15 years, ATD in Ireland has been close to family members facing persistent poverty and struggling daily to live in dignity. We are based in Dublin, at 26 Mountjoy Square – learn more about us by visiting our website www.atdireland.ie

Main tasks and responsibilities:

The intern will support the team and participate in the organisation of several major events and campaigns:

- The International UN Day for the Eradication of Poverty on 17th October: work with the Irish 17 October Committee to coordinate a commemoration on the Custom House quay in Dublin, making sure that the voice of the poorest are at the heart of this event. #EndPoverty Day (visit www.17october.ie)
- The International UN Human Rights Day on December 10th

- "Our Voices 2017": a European project conducted in partnership with teams in Poland and Spain aiming to deepen discussions on the future of Europe, underlining the idea of an inclusive social Europe, and enhancing participation of people living social exclusion situations on those debates.

- "We are One to Leave No One Behind": a major one year public campaign starting on 17 October 2016. This campaign is designed to reinforce the citizens and states' commitments towards the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda and the pledge to leave no one behind. The campaign will also be an opportunity to mark the centenary of the birth in 1917 of Joseph Wresinski, a champion of the Human Rights based and participatory approaches to poverty issues. He coined the concept of "Social Exclusion" and initiated the UN #EndPoverty Day in 1987. (visit www.facebook.com/WR1in2017/)

- -Liaise with volunteers, friends and partners
- -Participate in the organisation of public events
- -Communicate about the campaigns (social media...)
- -Perform general office and administrative tasks as assigned
- -Conduct research
