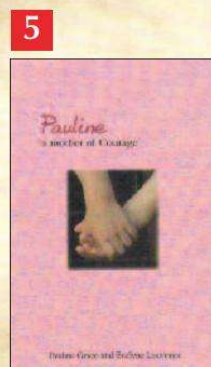

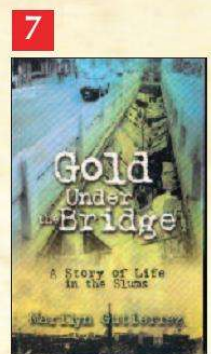
5 • Pauline: A Mother of Courage by Pauline Grace and Evelyn Louveaux (A Pen Press Publication)

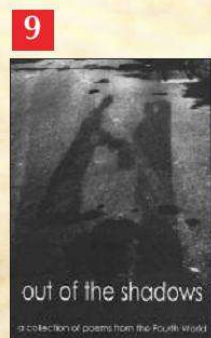
7 • Gold under the Bridge: A Story of Life in the Slums by Marilyn Gutierrez (Anvil Publishing)

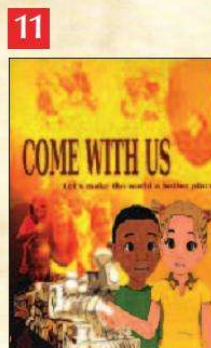
9 • Out of the Shadows

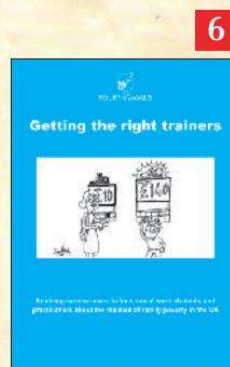
11 • Come With Us: Let's Make the World a Better Place

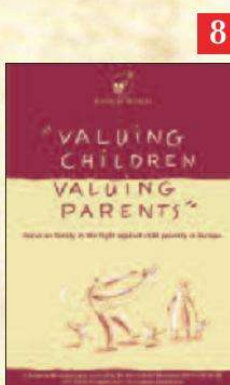
6 • Getting the Right Trainers: Enabling Service Users to Train Social Work Practitioners and Students about the Realities of Family Poverty in the UK

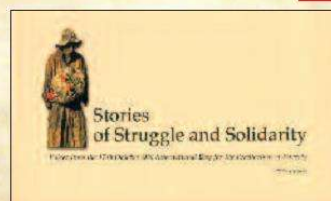
8 • Valuing Children, Valuing Parents: Focus on the Family in the Fight against Child Poverty in Europe

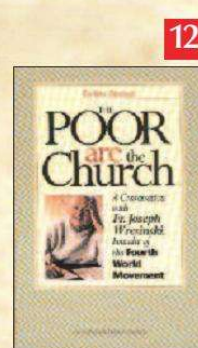
10 • Stories of Struggles and Solidarity: Voices from the 17th October UN International Day for the Eradication of Poverty

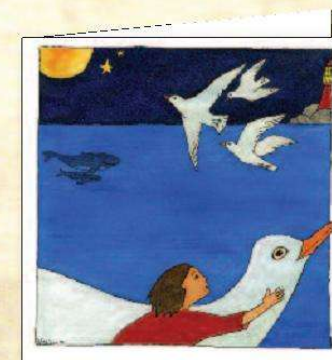

2. Challenge 2015: Towards Sustainable Development that Leaves No One Behind

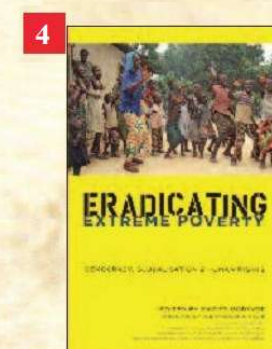

4 • Eradicating Extreme Poverty: Democracy, Globalisation and Human Rights £ 19.99 / € 22 / Can\$ 28

After decades of failed development policies, this book outlines a radical new approach rooted in the experiences, capabilities and strategies of those living in extreme poverty themselves. Aimed at policy makers, researchers, students and academics, it uses life stories from Burkina Faso, France, Peru and the Philippines to show that people trapped in chronic poverty must be involved in their own liberation.
