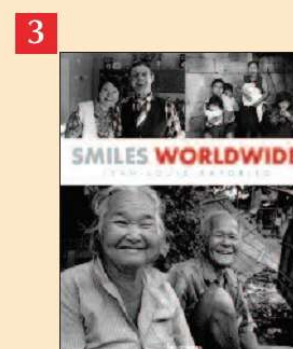
**1 • Eradicating Extreme Poverty:
Democracy, Globalisation and
Human Rights**

After decades of failed development policies, this book outlines a radical new approach rooted in the experiences, capabilities and strategies of those living in extreme poverty themselves. Aimed at policy makers, researchers, students and academics, it uses life stories from Burkina Faso, France, Peru and the Philippines to show that people trapped in chronic poverty must be involved in their own liberation.

People experiencing poverty are often categorised in terms of what they are lacking, their failures and their problems. 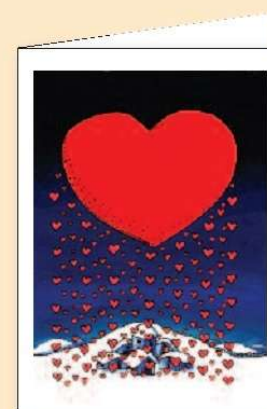
Books and DVDs

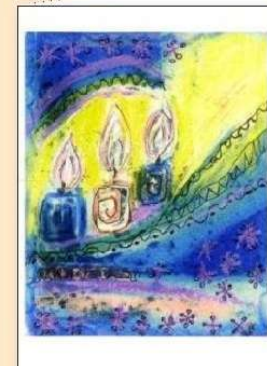

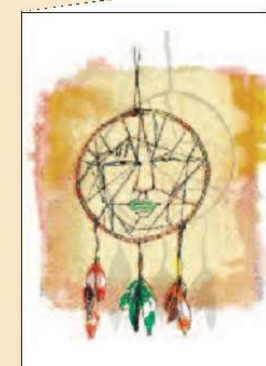
